

I don't recommend watching this, it's not a great film at all.





TOO GOOD TO MYTH




Almost Home is about a girl named Sugar and her struggle to survive with her mom Reba and her dog Shush.

Oh, and her mom is a jerk to the couple that watched Sugar while SHE was in the hospital recovering.


This book just isn't very good, and I do not recommend reading it

square frame.


Then she went down and perfectly illustrated his brown pants and blood colored bow tie. Finally, she added his holes and finished his face.
