- I. Roll Call - B. Tamol, S. Jacobs, J. Yarborough, R. Taughrin, C. Pudlewski, M. Heath, K. Stock (Library Director), D. Stempniak (Friends liaison), M. Studley (Town Board liaison), K. Bucki (liaison from Central Library Board)
- II. The meeting was called to order at 4:05 p.m.
- III. Agenda approved. MSP - Tamol, Heath Vote - unanimous
- IV. The June meeting minutes approved. MSP - Taughrin, Heath. Vote - unanimous
- V. K. Stock informed the Board that Congressman Langworthy's office presented a certificate to Meghan in recognition of her services to Children's programming. Assemblyman Chludzinski is coming Tuesday, July 14th to kick off "Xmas in July" toy drive. Both PT pages are leaving, interviews are being held. Lancaster Garden Walk – The library participated in this annual event on Saturday, July 18th and Sunday, July 19th. A special thank you to our Caretaker, Joshua Strell, for taking such good care of our gardens!

Lancaster Youth Bureau – The Youth Bureau held a hands-on summer craft program on Wednesday, July 8th for **9** children.

Trinity Food Pantry - The library collected non-perishable food for this organization.

PROGRAMMING - CHILDREN & TEENS

Board Game Club – Genevieve held this program on Thursday, July 2nd. **14** children played a variety of board games.

Book Battle – Part-time Librarian Michael Green held meetings of this club each Saturday. The **7** members are reading *Gilda Joyce, Psychic Investigator* by Jennifer Allison and *The Maze Runner* by James Dashner to prepare for a Lancaster v. Lancaster Battle-of-the-Books-style trivia competition in early August.

Book Bedazzle – Youth Services Librarian Meagan Carr helped **16** teens add some bling to their book covers on Wednesday, July 1st.

Cactus Craft – **11** teens created a mini cactus in a clay pot using paints and sharpies on Wednesday, July 22nd.

Craft Kits – We gave out a variety of free kits this month:

- **New Library Card Welcome Kit** – **28** children received this kit after getting their first library card!
- **STEM Kit: DIY Chalk** – **40** children picked up this kit.
- **Take & Make** – These weekly kits had book themes and **175** were picked up.



Crafternoon – Meagan held this program each Wednesday afternoon. Children created stepping stones, fairy houses, foil art, and glow in the dark art.

Edible Dinosaurs – Liz Bauld, the Storybook Cook, showed **25** children how to create edible dinosaur treats, an exploding volcano, and a dinosaur dig with edible bones and dirt on Friday, July 10th.

Family Yoga – **20** participants enjoyed music, yoga poses, mindful activities, and a guided relaxation time with certified instructor Donna Baia on Monday, July 6th.

Hula Hoop Workshop – Benjamin Berry taught **16** children how to find the perfect-sized hoop, create and decorate their hoop, and learn beginner-friendly hooping moves on Tuesday, July 7th.

Feelings Rock – A total of **21** preschool age children attended this program on Monday, July 20th. They enjoyed a fun music and movement class that encourages families to move, learn, and grow together.

Fossils, Fossils, Everywhere – Penn Dixie Fossil Park taught **28** people about fossils and how they form featuring plant, marine, and dinosaur examples on Thursday, July 23rd.

LEGO® Club – Meagan held a LEGO® Club for a total of **15** children on Friday, July 24th. The theme was creator's choice.

Origami Book Making – The WNY Book Arts Center taught **19** children how to make their own book on Friday, July 17th.

Puppet Show – Omnipresent Puppet Theater presented *Bonnie's Brachiosaurus* on Monday, July 27th for **77** people.

Scavenger Hunt - **405** children of all ages looked for dinosaur book characters in the children's area of our library.

Storytimes - Meagan conducted a total of **20** sessions this month. **64** children attended Lapsit, **88** children attended Family Storytime, **120** children attended Toddler Time, and **86** children attended Preschool Time.

Thursday Performers – We hosted a different performer each Thursday morning with a total attendance of **510** people of all ages. Performers were Magician Ted Burzynski, Hawk Creek Wildlife Center, Safari Sam's Dino-Tastic Adventure, and Puppeteer Mike Randall.

Teen Painting – Art educator Kimberly Strell taught **10** teenagers how to create a beach-themed painting on Monday, July 13th.

Book Roses – **10** adults learned how to create gorgeous roses from book pages on Wednesday, July 15th.

Chess Club – A member of the Buffalo Chess Association taught **11** people of all ages how to play this game on Tuesday, July 14th.

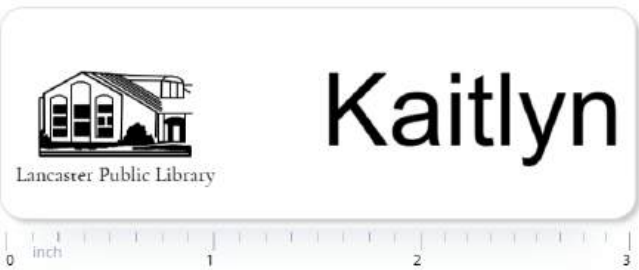
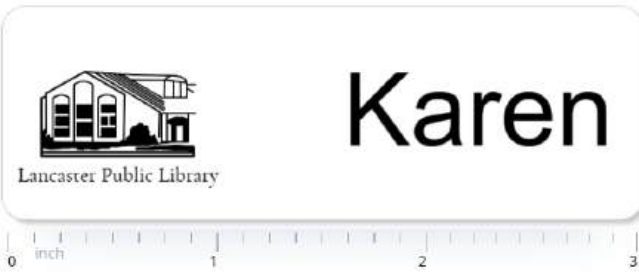

The Lancaster Public Library (LPL) welcomes and encourages children to visit, use library resources and services, and attend library programs. Staff members are available to help and support children; however, the LPL is not able to provide short or long-term child care, or be responsible for unattended children.

No children under ten (10) years of age may be left unattended in the library at any time. Library staff will not be responsible for children who have been left without adult supervision. The staff reserves the right to seek the intervention of appropriate law enforcement or social services agencies, as required by individual circumstances.

For the safety and protection of children, all children subject to the State Laws requiring school attendance are forbidden the use of the library during regular school hours without special permit or previous arrangement with school officials or the home-schooling parent.
