Year in Review

Programs

943 children and adults attended 52 in library programs. 174 children attended 171 one-on-one program sessions. 102 children registered for The New York State Summer Reading Program "All Together Now". We held 11 early literacy programs that were attended by 89 children and parents.

Our Book Club and Lego Club held monthly meetings. We celebrated Take Your Child to the Library Day, we brought back our popular Build a Leprechaun Trap program, we had a Fairy Tale Scavenger Hunt and a Halloween Costume party for kids. We had our March Madness Book Edition, children read 12 picture books and voted to crown a champion. The 2023 champion was Creepy Carrots by Aaron Reynolds. We ended the year with our Make a Graham Cracker House program.

We had 11 summer programs, which included story hours, What's Cooking, Build a Tiny World terrarium program as well as Fur Feathers and Scales presented by Hawk Creek and Cris Johnson provided families with a Magic Show and Balloon Twisting experience.

We offered our very popular Take and Make activity kits. The kits include book lists, activities and a craft. Take and Makes included Groundhog's Day, Make a Valentine, St. Patrick's Day, Easter, Libraries, Mother's Day, Father's Day, Fall, Halloween, Thanksgiving and Holiday Ornaments.

Marilla Primary School classes visited the library. We also provided tours to Girl Scout troops.

We partnered with Erie County to provide Emergency Homecare Kits to the community.

We held a Family Fun Fest fundraiser in conjunction with the Marilla Fire Company Benevolent Association Picnic in August. We also provided kids activities at the Town of Marilla Ag-Day in September.

History of the Marilla Free Library

In 1912, a group of citizens under the leadership of Dr. and Mrs. L.B. Lougee, formed a book circle. This group called themselves the Book Lover's Club. The first library began in the home of the Lougees and remained there for 23 years. In May of 1936 the existing library building was dedicated. It had been built through the efforts of this local library association. In 1948, the Marilla Free Library was invited to join the Buffalo and Erie County Public Library system. Mrs. Lougee was the first librarian and continued in that position for 41 years, until 1956.
