

Marilla Free Library Trustee Application Process

Marilla Free Library (the Library) a branch of the Buffalo and Erie County Public Library (B&ECPL)

Those interested in becoming a trustee will be asked to fill out the Trustee Application. A file of applications will be maintained until an opening on the board of Trustees is available.

When an opening does become available, the Board will review all of the applications on file, and invite applicants for a short interview at a meeting.

Once applicants have been interviewed, Board members will vote by ballot on whether the applicant should fill the empty Board position.

If approved, the Applicant then takes the Oath of Office at a suitable time, no more than 30 days after approval, and fills out the rest of the necessary paperwork.
