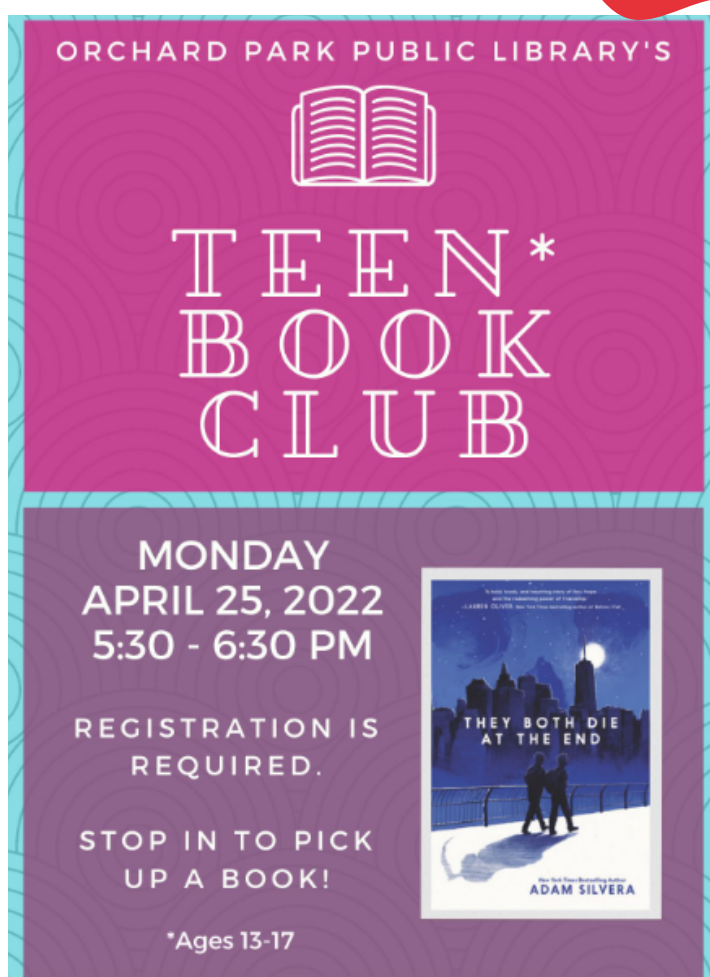

Teen-Only Take & Make Craft!

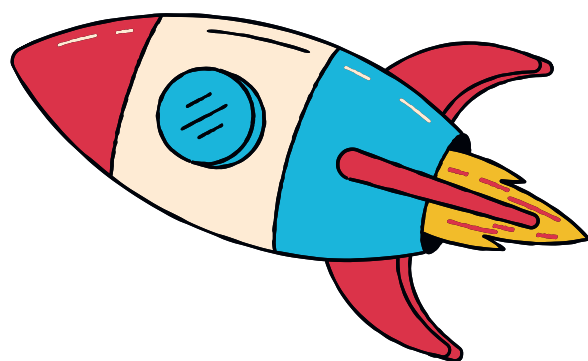


Starting this month, the Orchard Park Library will be offering monthly Teen-Only Take & Make Craft Kits! April's craft is a mini book keychain!

This program is for ages 13-17. Call us (662-9851) or visit us at the Library to sign up!

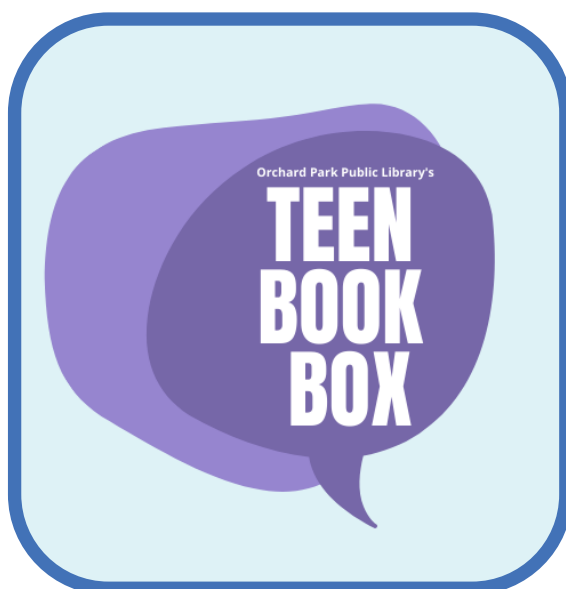
Teen Book Boxes!
