## National Library Month

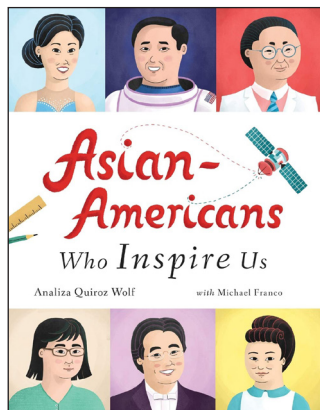

# Asian American and Pacific Islander Heritage Month

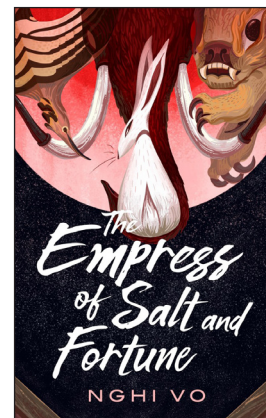

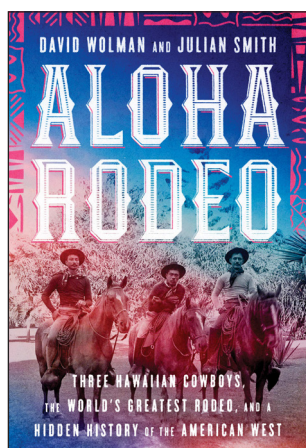

# LGBTQ+ Pride Month

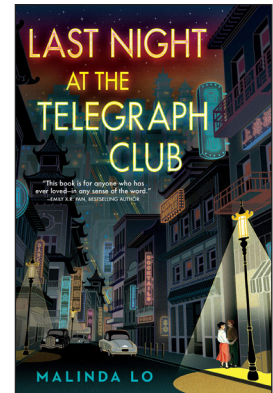

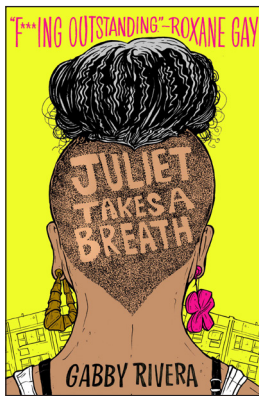

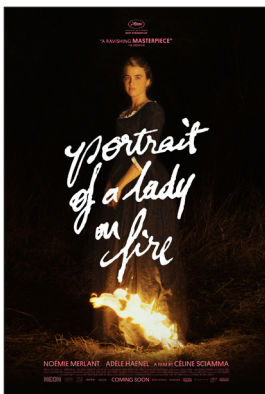
