Child Care Book Drop service

- What is the Road2Reading service?
 The Road2Reading Child Care Book Drop is a free service offered by the Buffalo & Erie County Public Library System that brings children's material directly to preschools and childcare centers across Erie County. Monthly deliveries allow classrooms to check out new material to engage their students throughout the year.
- Who is eligible for the *Road2Reading* service?

 Preschools, early childhood education centers, and childcare centers located in Erie County.
- What types of library materials can be borrowed?

 Any type of children's material can be borrowed, including picture books, board books, nonfiction children's books, DVDs, and CDs.
- How many items can be borrowed?
 Up to 30 items can be borrowed.

- How long is the borrowing period?
 All items are borrowed for 4 weeks.
- How are the items returned?

 The Library2GO van will return to your location monthly to pick up returns and deliver new material.
- Do I need a library card?

 All library material must be checked out to a teacher's library card or a facility's agency card. If you do not have a card already, we can help you sign up for a free card today.
- Yes. Desired themes, authors, and titles can be requested for the next delivery. However, there is no guarantee that specific items will be available.
